

creates local and international projects and coaches local youth initiatives. Besides providing training and other non-formal educational possibilities, the volunteers of TE-IS organize different cultural and leisure time activities based on the needs of its target group.







The "All Colors of Education" project is designed to enhance the educational process by promoting the use of graphic facilitation and visual thinking tools. Its main objectives include:

- Raising awareness about the importance of visual tools in education and youth work.
- Building a personal visual library and understanding the basics of visual language.
- Practicing sketch-noting and graphic recording for efficient visualization of concepts.
- Recognizing the benefits of visuals in memory retention, motivation, attention-grabbing, and prompting action.
- Grasping the concept of graphic facilitation and its application in different scenarios.
- Encouraging the use of graphical tools for creativity and critical thinking.
- Exploring online visual thinking tools and platforms for online learning.
- Enhancing self-expression and minimizing misunderstandings.
- Aiming for a ripple effect in the competence development of visual thinking in education and youth work.
- Developing visual aids for self-learning in visual thinking and graphic facilitation.

The project will be structured around two training courses, with an online course in between to bridge knowledge gaps and deepen understanding of the project's theme.

# THE STRUCTURE

The first TC 07-15.11.2023 Ivancice, the Czech Republic


Experiential training on graphic tools for youth education, focused on hands-on techniques, codrawing, and visual thinking in a collaborative environment.

#### Homework

An interim homework phase includes an online marathon to hone visual skills, followed by a practice phase for real-world application.

The second TC 14 - 22.03.2024

Ivancice, the Czech Republic delves into digital visual thinking, its applicability, and its pros and cons in youth work. Emphasizing the digital age's impact on youth, the course underscores visual communication's role online.



# TRAINING COURSE 1

Our inclusive training course, centered on experiential learning. In a diverse, interactive environment, participants will explore graphic tools for youth work and education. The course emphasizes hands-on, informal methods, guiding learners in skills like creating engaging flipcharts and co-drawing. Everyone is encouraged to sketch and use visual thinking tools. Our co-working spaces foster creativity and collaboration, enhancing analytical and communication abilities. With a focus on the 'learn-tolearn' approach, participants set personal goals, engage with peers, and benefit from feedback. By the end, attendees will have tangible skills and products to enhance their educational endeavors.



## PARTICIPANTS

The training course is open for educators - trainers, teachers, facilitators, youth workers, youth leaders.




#### Criteria for selection

- 18+
- fluent in English
- truthful engagement and motivation to study the theme of the project, willingness to share individual and professional knowledge, and to learn in the international group
- participation in all the stages of LTTC
- distinct ideas for follow up at local/national and international level
- some acquaintance in the theme of youth empowerment and great motivation to look into this theme
- openness for and the gratitude of non-formal learning approach in excessive diversity structure
- commitment to go through the whole longterm learning process
- excessive commitment for follow up activities and networking







## WHAT NEXT YOUHAVE TOKNOW

- you have to receive an confirmation email about your acceptation from a project organizer (Markéta Chmelíčková)
- you will receive a participation agreement, this agreement will be signed on the spot
- you have to send your travel plan for approval
- do not buy any travel tickets without approval of project organizer (Markéta)
- invitation letters (in the case of need) will be prepared as soon as we receive an application
- if you need our help or support within inclusion, write this to the application
- you will receive a Youthpass certificate - recognizing the results of your nonformal and informal learning



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### TRAVELLING


- arrival day is 07.11.2023
- meeting point is 07.11.2023 at 5 pm in BRNO –
   BUS STATION Grand Hotel
- later arrivals of participants will be solved by train connections from Brno to Ivančice (last train 10:54 pm)
- departure day is 15.11.2023, plan the connection from 7 to 10:30 am from BRNO
- respect that it is tolerated taveling within 2 days before and after TC, i.e. 08.11. and 14.11.
- use the cheapest means of transport

#### Traveling by plane

- you can come to Prague/Václav Havel Airport or Brno/ Tuřany Airport or Vienna/Schwechat Airport
- you can use the buses of the Student Agency, www.studentagency.eu, from Prague and Vienna to BRNO BUS STATION Grand Hotel
- you can go by public transport from Brno/Tuřany Airport to the centre of Brno

#### Travelling by bus and train

- you have to reach Brno BUS STATION Grand Hotel
- you can come to the central railway station (3 minutes by walk from the bus station Grand Hotel) or direct to the bus station Grand Hotel or to the bus station Zvonarka (10 minutes by walk from the bus station Grand Hotel)



### REIMBURSEMENT




- travel costs and visa costs will be reimbursed based on actual costs
- travel costs to the maximum which is determined by the European Commission (based on the actual distance)

## IMPORTANT

- the costs will be reimbursed to the bank account of the participant within one month after receiving all documents and filling in the PARTICIPANTS REPORT
- the costs can be reimbursed to the bank account of the sending organization based on the invoice
- the costs can be reimbursed in cash in CZK on the spot if the participant submits all documents
- following the guidelines of the Erasmus+ Program and internal regulations, the travel must be released by the participants in a direct way within a maximum of 2 days (before and after activity days), in case of long pauses or indirect routes (holiday travel), there is no reimbursement of travel costs
- the travel documents are plane tickets, invoices (not only boarding paper), but boarding also passes (for all the parts of air travel), ORIGINAL or electronic bus/train tickets,
- the visa documents are ORIGINAL bills, ORIGINAL or electronic bus/train tickets, invoices
- in the case of the postage it is borne by the participant
- the outgoing bank fees are borne by the organization, the incoming bank fees are borne by the participant
- participants of other nationality must prove their residence permit

YOU ARE EXPECTED TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL THE ACTIVITIES UNLESS YOU ARE ILL. UNAUTHORIZED ABSENCE FROM ACTIVITIES AND WORKSHOPS IS NOT PERMITTED IF LESS THAN 90% OF THE PROGRAM IS ATTENDED, IT WILL NOT BE POSSIBLE TO BE REIMBURSED FOR THE TRAVEL COSTS.

## ACCOMMODATION




- the participants will be accommodated in Středisko volného času Ivančice, Zemědělská 619/2, 66491 Ivančice

- any special requests regarding the meal e.g. vegetarian, vegan, allergies, special diet should be communicated before the start of the activity















#### WHAT TO BRING


- it is necessary to have insurance coverage
